Project Overview

Ontario Tech U (OTU) and Tech for Good Canada (TFGC) are collaborating on a research project aimed at studying online Canadian youth activism and promoting pro-social civic engagement with digital media.

The research project includes an online social activism challenge called, "We Stop Scrolling"
